

**WATERLINE REPLACEMENT AND STREETSCAPE
PROJECT UPDATE AS OF
SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2019**

Preliminary work has begun for the waterline replacement of the streetscape project.

Road construction signs and detour signs have been placed and installed at numerous locations along US Hwy 21, advising drivers that Main Street is closed to thru traffic. This is being done to encourage the use of the Sparta Parkway for traffic that is just passing through town.

The Main Street is open for business for anyone who needs to do business in town and all businesses are open for their regular business hours.

On Monday, September 9, the construction crew will begin setting up traffic barrels to temporarily route traffic into travel lanes. The contractor will begin digging holes in the pavement to locate the exact location and depth of the existing waterline.

During this time, the center lane will be utilized to maintain two-way travel for traffic. This will minimize the need to stop traffic. Some parking spaces will be blocked at this time for the contractor to work.

The construction for the new waterline will begin at Trojan Avenue and move south. This date is not yet established as there is still preliminary work to be done.

As soon as more information is available, it will be posted.
