

WATERLINE REPLACEMENT AND STREETSCAPE PROJECT UPDATE AS OF THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2019

On Thursday morning at 8 a.m., the contractor will begin digging the line and installing the new waterline, beginning at the intersection of Trojan Avenue, and proceeding to the main intersection. There will be periods of traffic delay while the waterline is laid through the intersection at Trojan Avenue.

Road construction signs and detour signs have been placed and installed at locations along US Hwy 21. This is being done to encourage the use of the Sparta Parkway for traffic that is just passing through town. Message boards are placed on each end of Sparta Parkway, showing roadwork ahead and for traffic to follow the detour.

The Main Street is open for business for anyone who needs to do business in town and all businesses are open for their regular business hours.

During this time, the center lane will be utilized to maintain two-way travel for traffic. This will minimize the need to stop traffic. Some parking spaces will be blocked at this time for the contractor to work.

The construction for the new waterline will begin at Trojan Avenue and move south. This work is now underway.

On Thursday evening, September 19th, beginning at 7:00 p.m. the contractor plans to be working through the night to install the waterline at the main intersection, US 21 and NC 18. The intersection will be closed through the night until the waterline installation is complete. It is anticipated that the work will be complete by 7:00 a.m. on Friday morning, but the intersection will remain closed until the work is complete.

Thank you for your patience, cooperation, and understanding as we get underway with the construction of the new waterline.
