

**WATERLINE REPLACEMENT AND STREETSCAPE
PROJECT UPDATE AS OF
FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2019**

Construction schedule for the week of September 16 will be similar to the current situation. The installation of waterline will continue down Main Street, in front of the Methodist Church, crossing Doughton Street, and into the downtown area. The traffic pattern using the turn lane as a traffic lane will continue the same.

The waterline work at Trojan Avenue is now complete and there should be minimal interruptions to traffic at Trojan Avenue.

On Thursday evening, September 19th, beginning about 7:30 p.m., the contractor will close Main Street at the main intersection of US 21 & NC Hwy 18. The contractor will be working through the night to install the waterline through the intersection. The intersection will be closed until 7:00 a.m. on Friday morning, or until the work is complete.

Road construction signs and detour signs will continue to be evaluated. We have two important objectives to accomplish:

1. We need to minimize the amount of unnecessary traffic through the work zone for safety and encourage thru traffic to use the Parkway.
2. We need to encourage the support of the downtown businesses, so access to the downtown businesses is very important.

The Main Street is open for business for anyone who needs to do business in town and all businesses are open for their regular business hours.

The center lane will be utilized to maintain two-way travel for traffic. This will minimize the need to stop traffic. Some parking spaces will be blocked at this time for the contractor to work.
