Crouse Park

Children's Playground, Basketball Court, and Skateboard Court at Crouse Park to remained Closed until Further Notice.

Walking path and picnic shelters are open to the public.

Governor Cooper has signed Executive Order No. 138 to modify the Stay At Home Order and transition to Phase 1 of easing some restrictions. At the town council meeting last week there was discussion about Crouse Park and modifying certain restrictions at the park, but understanding that COVID-19 continues to be serious health threat. Therefore, the town council agreed that certain activities at the park will continue to be restricted, as follows: 1) Crouse House will remain closed. 2) Children's playground will remain closed. 3) Basketball court will remain closed. 4) Skateboard park will remain closed.

The Pickleball court will be open for use. The picnic shelters will be open for use. The walking path continues to be open for use.

When using the park facilities, please continue to use the following precautions: 1) Maintain social distancing of 6-feet or more. 2) Limit the size of group activities to 10 persons or less. 3) Please wear face coverings.

These are preventive measures to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus and lessen the impact on our community. The town is taking precautions to ensure the health and safety of its citizens during this rapidly changing situation.
