

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE SEALED BID SALE

WHEREAS, the Town of Sparta owns multiple fleet vehicles, and

WHEREAS, certain vehicles have surpassed their operational lifespan with the Town, and their services are consequently no longer required as part of the Town's fleet.

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute § 160A-267 authorizes the Town to conduct the sale of property through private sale when the property is appraised at a value of less than \$30,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE SPARTA TOWN:

1. The Town Council hereby grants authorization for the sale of the specified fleet vehicles through sealed bidding procedures.
 - a. **1987 Ford F-800 Trash Truck – VIN 1FDYK84A3JVA06020**
 - b. **1997 CHEVROLET C7500 Dump Truck – VIN 1GBM7H1J6WJ105748**
 - c. **2005 F350 Work Truck – VIN 1FDSF35P55EA46993**
2. The Town will accept sealed bids for the real property until 3:00 PM on Friday, August 7, 2026. Bids should be submitted to the Town Manager at 304 South Main Street, Sparta, NC 28675.
3. Bids will be publicly opened at 3:30 PM on Friday, August 7, and the vehicle will be awarded to the highest bidder following the bid process.
4. The Town shall notify the successful bidder and secure the full payment within seven days of notification. Should the successful bidder fail to make the payment, the Town Manager is hereby authorized to proceed with the next highest bidder.
5. All vehicles are sold in their current condition, without any warranties, guarantees, or assurances. All sales are final at the point of transaction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Manager is hereby authorized to proceed with the private sale of the above-mentioned assets.
